



School Uniform Policy

The School Board believes a school dress code fosters and enhances school and team spirit, ensures safety, encourages equity and instils pride in our students whilst identifying them in our local community.

The school expects every student to be in school uniform. Enrolment at the school is on the understanding that the school's dress code will be adhered to. Classes on excursion must be uniform, unless the consent of the Principal to vary this has been granted.

DRESS CODE

Tops

- Tapping Primary School polo shirt
- Year 6 only - Tapping Primary School Leavers polo shirt
- Faction Colour shirts may be worn on Sports days and events.

Bottoms

- Plain black shorts (appropriate length)
- Plain black track pants
- Plain black skorts (appropriate length)
- Thick black leggings may be worn by Kindy and Pre-Primary students only.

Jackets

- Plain black jacket
- Tapping Primary School jacket

Footwear

- Sensible, closed-in and sport appropriate shoes
- Plain black or white ankle socks

Hats

- Wide brimmed black hats must be worn for lunch, recess and physical education lessons

Hair and Accessories

- Hairstyles should be short, neat and natural
- All hairstyles must not create a health and safety risk, therefore hair below the collar must be tied up at all times
- Hair ribbons and ties must be black, white, tortoiseshell or the school colour only
- Non-smart watches may be worn
- One pair of small standard stud earrings or sleepers in plain silver, gold or clear may be worn
- One single necklace or bracelet may be worn for medical, religious or cultural reasons
- Makeup, if any, should only be natural in appearance and be kept to a minimum

Other Considerations

- Please contact school administration to discuss any further accommodations for medical, cultural and religious reasons.

Non-Permitted Items

- Branded clothing, striped clothing, cargo pants, denim jeans, long-sleeved shirts, tights, skirts, boots, thongs, nail treatments and nail polish are not permitted.
